

Three EIZO LCD Monitors Among the First Products Awarded TCO'03 FPD Certification



Matto, Japan, March 7, 2003 – Eizo Nanao Corporation is proud to announce that three of its monitors received certification for the international TCO'03 FPD (Flat Panel Displays) label when the first compliant products were recently announced by TCO Development of Sweden. TCO'03 FPD is the fourth generation of TCO certifications and establishes stricter standards than its predecessor TCO'99 for ergonomics, emissions, and ecology to create a safer, more comfortable

working environment. The three certified monitors are the FlexScan L367, L767, and L985EX². EIZO expects to broaden its offerings of TCO'03 certified monitors in the coming months with several models under application.

"As a company that has always placed a high priority on environmental preservation and user comfort and safety, we are delighted that our monitors are among the first to receive certification for the new TCO'03 FPD label," said Kunihiro Arata, general manager of Eizo Nanao Corporation's Overseas Sales & Marketing Division. TCO Development Background

TCO Development seeks to create comfortable office working conditions by developing quality certification for office equipment and environmental labeling systems for the assessment of office work environments. Since the 1980's, TCO Development has been dealing with the issues of making computer monitors as safe as possible by consulting with manufacturers and user representatives. The first environmental guideline issued as a result of this collaboration was TCO 1992, which established standards for electric and magnetic fields, energy efficiency, and electrical safety. EIZO collaborated with TCO Development in the formulation of TCO 1992 and in subsequent versions of the label — TCO'95, TCO'99, and now TCO'03.
