

FlexScan L565 from EIZO Raises Performance Standards for 17-inch LCD Monitors

Compact design, stereo speakers, and outstanding image quality present a complete flat panel product for the business environment

Matto, Japan, February 22, 2002 – Eizo Nanao Corporation today introduced its first 17-inch flat panel display, the FlexScan L565. 19-inch CRT users looking to regain lost desktop space will find this model provides both leading technical specifications and performance benefits that warrant a jump to LCD technology. The large viewable image area and sleek design with integrated speakers make a valuable addition to any business environment from small offices to financial institutions.

"Many users of 19" CRT monitors have delayed switching to LCD monitors because of such disadvantages as limited color reproduction capabilities and narrow viewing angles," said Kunihiro Arata, General Manager of Eizo Nanao Corporation's Overseas Sales & Marketing Division. "However, with the FlexScan L565 not only have we addressed these concerns, but also incorporated the latest technology trends such as digital and analog inputs and an sRGB mode, making the reasons to upgrade are even more compelling."

Super-IPS Panel for Sharper Images and Wider Viewing Angles

The FlexScan L565 uses leading LCD technology with its Super-IPS (In-Plane Switching) panel that guarantee crisp images and unmatched color fidelity. The native resolution is 1280 × 1024, brightness, 230 cd/m² and contrast ratio an impressive 400:1. The 30 ms response time facilitates smooth video playback without any jittering. Extremely wide viewing angles of 170° horizontal and vertical assure on-screen data remains clearly readable and color shift is minimized. The color reproduction range of the panel is now on par with the color space established by the European Broadcasting Union. Additionally, an sRGB mode assures color matching with other peripherals that support this standard.

Space-Saving Design

As with all recent LCD releases from EIZO the FlexScan L565 features a thin bezel for greater desktop space savings. The sides measure only 20 mm so overall width is just 380 mm. Total depth is a mere 178 mm even with the built-in power supply unit. The VESA compliant mounting interface allows for placement on a wall or adjustable arm. Integrated stereo speakers (1 watt + 1 watt) further compliment the compact design while supporting multimedia applications.

Dual Inputs for Digital and Analog Connectivity

No matter what the system, the FlexScan L565 provides the necessary connection flexibility



to match. The digital (DVI-D) input eliminates any image degradation from signal conversion, and the analog (D-Sub mini 15 pin) input assures compatibility with conventional computer systems. When two computers are connected to the monitor simultaneously, toggling between the two is as simple as pressing a button on the front panel.

Compliance with Leading Regulatory Standards

The FlexScan L565 meets the stringent requirements of both TCO'99¹ and TÜV/Ergonomics that cover such areas as reduced emissions and recycleability. Power consumption of less than 3 watts in standby mode lower energy costs and allow for compliance with both the EPA Energy Star® and Energy 2000 standards.

Screen Protection

To prevent scratches and dust, EIZO offers the optional FW-07, a thin, lightweight sheet made to fit comfortably over the screen and leave minimal trace of implementation.

Availability

The FlexScan L565 is now shipping and will go on sale worldwide in March. The cabinet is available in a choice of gray or black. Please contact the authorized EIZO distributor in your country for more details.
