

EIZO Begins Construction on Test and Evaluation Center for Compliance with MIL Standard

Hakusan, Japan, September 1, 2016 – EIZO Corporation (TSE: 6737) announced that today it began construction at its global headquarters in Hakusan, Japan on a test and evaluation center for compliance with the MIL Standard.

As per the mid-term business plan which EIZO announced in 2015, one of EIZO's priorities is to expand its monitor business in specialty markets. To develop and manufacture MIL Standard-visual display systems that compliant with the United States Department of Defense's Military Standard (hereafter Standard), EIZO decided to build a test and evaluation center at its headquarters.

Strict conditions, especially for reliability testing, are required among the various environmental testing standards in the MIL Standard. To meet the strict requirements, EIZO will implement the necessary facilities in its new test and evaluation center. It will also establish the basic technology and build the development and manufacturing environments to meet the MIL Standard.

The test and evaluation center will have a total floor space of 667 m² and be made of reinforced concrete and steel. Construction is scheduled for completion in March 2017 with operations to begin in April 2017. The center will include machines for testing vibration, depressurization, and particles. EIZO will invest approximately 800 million Japanese yen (7.7 million US dollars) in construction and testing facilities.

About MIL Standard

The MIL Standard is the United States Department of Defense's evaluation guidelines for procuring materials. It mandates the materials can be used and remain stable under conditions of extreme temperatures, humidity, vibration, and shock.
