#### **Background**

- Tim Flach's specialist field needs perfection and total precision. He shoots in the field, in sanctuaries and in studios. As such it is imperative that the control he has in post production is of an exceptionally high level in order to clearly see and edit details in the skin textures, each delicate hair, each subtle sculptural shadow. Close up detail needs to be correct and authentic.
- His work features in Fine Art Galleries, books, magazines and also advertising, as such he works at extremely high resolution and needs tools that enable him to concentrate on minute details of the image.
- Tim is different to many photographers in that he works all the way through the workflow, from concept to photo capture to editing to printing to the exhibition or book. This means he has an exceptional understanding and demands for needing the best quality and reliable professional tools.
